## WELCOME TO CERTIFICATE IN ISLAMIC STUDIES & LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME FOR YOUTH

Certificate In Islamic Studies & Leadership Programme for Youth is a 2-year, 8-module programme for students between the ages of 17-25 years old. It is an interactive, project-based programme curated for youth graduating from part-time Madrasahs. Each module spans 10 weeks, addressing current problems that students face in their daily lives. This is complemented by a week of Quranic lessons emphasising Tahsin Qur'an and Tajwid, two weeks of Da'wah modules, and an additional week dedicated to projects and activities that serve as assessment days.



#### **APPROACHES**

The hallmark of this program is its emphasis on experiential learning.

It aims to develop Muslim youth who are skilled in Da'wah and Islamic project management, spiritually strong, capable of internalizing their faith, and sharing its beauty with the community.

This approach prepares participants to become well-rounded future leaders, proficient in organisational and project management skills.

The programme underscores the importance of understanding fundamental Islamic knowledge, including Islamic creed, Ibadah, and Quranic literacy and beautification (Talaqqi and Tahsin).

It aims to develop Muslim youth who are skilled in Da'wah and Islamic project management, spiritually strong, capable of internalizing their faith, and sharing its beauty with the community.

Facilitators will ensure that the module objectives are met, enabling students to reflect on and internalise the lessons learned throughout the course.



#### QURANIC LITERACY TAHSIN QUR'AN



Upon entry, each student will undergo a filtration and sieving process to identify the Inspire Me Qur'an (IMQ) level.



Students will learn about Quranic reading rules for 1 session from every module.



Lecturer will ask students to read chosen text from the Quran to see their capability in reading and what can be improved.



Students need to reach at least IMQ level 3 to graduate for this programme.
